FPC Building Committee Update



The Church Building Project is moving steadily along with plans for the renovations and updates to our facilities. It may seem like nothing is happening, but I can assure you that is not the case. We recently met with the local Fire Marshal Kenneth Langston of Bradenton to discuss our building plans. Mr. Langston is in charge of the Fire Prevention Bureau. His primary concern was making sure our plans included sprinkler and fire alarm systems with any changes or additions to our buildings. Although our ultimate goal is to have all the facilities protected, he is willing to work with us to achieve that goal in the next 10-15 years.

Our contractor Halfacre is working on a conceptual budget to determine costs. Zoller-Autrey is working on design development and construction documents as we move forward. Mike Haney, Mechanical Engineer, is working on designing an efficient and effective HVAC System. 


- The property sales team was on hand to deliver an update on their progress.
